3. Status Report

Bill Ellison tabled the Fee Proposal for the proposed Macs Reef Road waste transfer station, a joint proposal from Quadro Australia Pty Ltd and Environmental Planning Services Pty Ltd.

The scope of the document was discussed at length, with particular reference to the Noise, Vibration and Air Assessment, and the benefit to be derived from the inclusion of optional photomontages of the proposed development.
